



## RV/Motorcycle Coverage

RV/Motorcycle Membership covers motorhomes, pickup trucks with campers, and motorcycles. RV/Motorcycle Coverage can be added to Plus- or Premier-level Memberships.

Coverage includes:

*RV/Motorcycle coverage does not cover service on boat, utility or livestock trailers. Vehicles must be registered as recreational vehicles.*

### Required information for motorhome Emergency Roadside Assistance calls:

- Class of motorhomes
- Length of motorhomes
- Location of motor (front or back)
- Does the vehicle have dual wheels?  
If it does, and the motorhome needs tire service, which tire needs the service?
- Number of axles
- If the vehicle is out of fuel, does it take gas or diesel?

### Required information for camper Emergency Roadside Assistance calls:

- Type of camper (pop up camper, bumper pull camper, or a fifth wheel)
- Pop up camper or bumper pull camper, size of the ball hitch
- Length of the camper
- Number of axles
- Does the camper have dual wheels?  
If it does, and the camper needs tire service (tire change, plug or air up) which tire needs the service?
