The AAA School Safety Patrol program was established in 1920 and has been an institution in schools for more than 100 years. Dedicated students have been volunteering their time, rain or shine, to help ensure the safety of their classmates as they travel to and from school each day.

Thousands of elementary students from within Ohio Auto Club's 38 county service area volunteer each year. Nationwide, membership exceeds 679,000 annually.

There has been a significant reduction in the number of deaths and injuries to school age children, due in part to the widespread popularity of the AAA School Safety Patrol program.
